Staff consists of 13 full time teachers, 5 SNAs, secretary, caretaker, cleaner and bus escort.

The Board of Management of Swinford NS invites applications for the position of Deputy Principal. This is a permanent position and the appointment will be made via open competition. The Deputy Principal will work with the Principal and with the in-school leadership team to support and develop effective leadership and management within the school.

Recruitment will be in line with Circular 0044/2019 and so the selection of the successful candidate shall be based on four competencies which are aligned to the Quality Framework for Leadership and Management, which are:

- 1. Leading Learning and Teaching
- 2. Managing the Organisation
- 3. Leading school development
- 4. Developing leadership capacity.

In line with the above domains and working closely with the Principal, the duties attached to the

role involve whole school curricular development, policy development, day-to-day management of resources and personnel and long-term strategic planning for the future development of the school.

The successful candidate must hold a certificate to teach religion in a Catholic school. The Deputy Principal will be expected to uphold and promote the ethos, values, and traditions of the school.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria: Fully registered under Route 1 (Primary) with the Teaching Council and have 5 years recognised teaching service, two of which must be in a recognised primary school within the Republic of Ireland.
